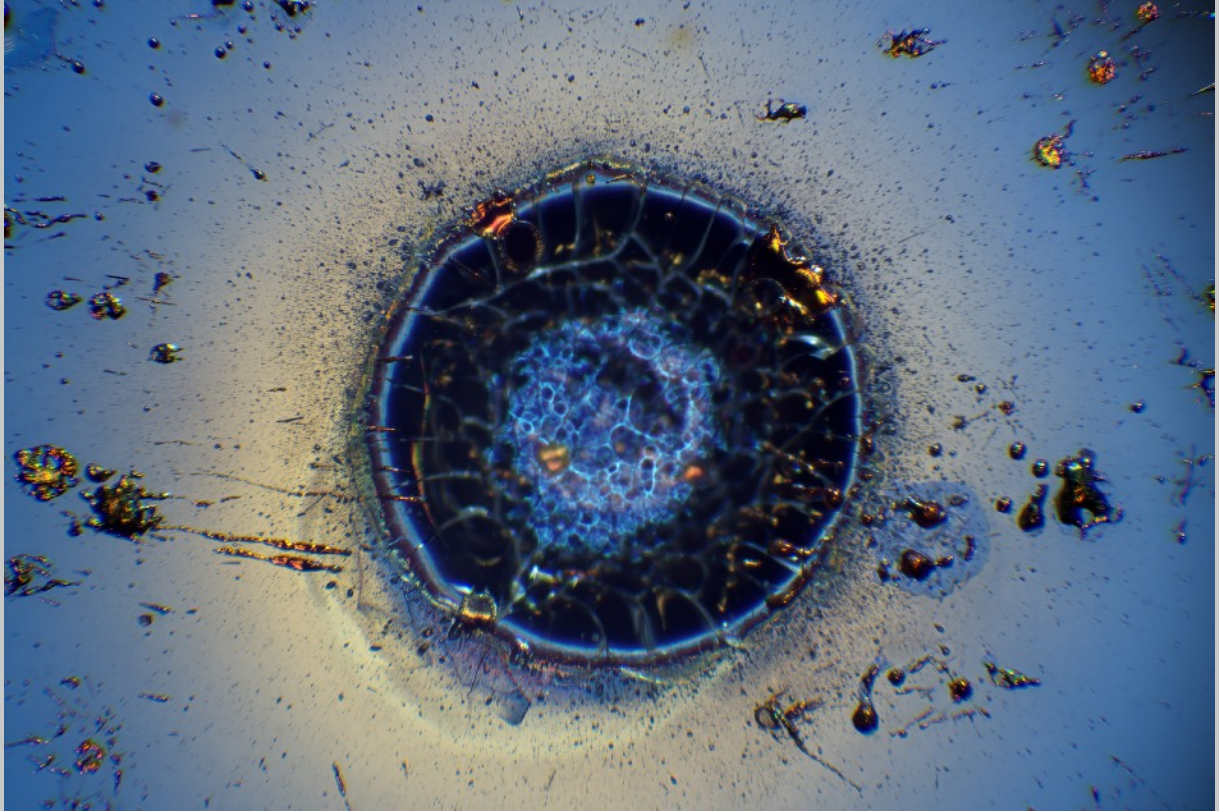

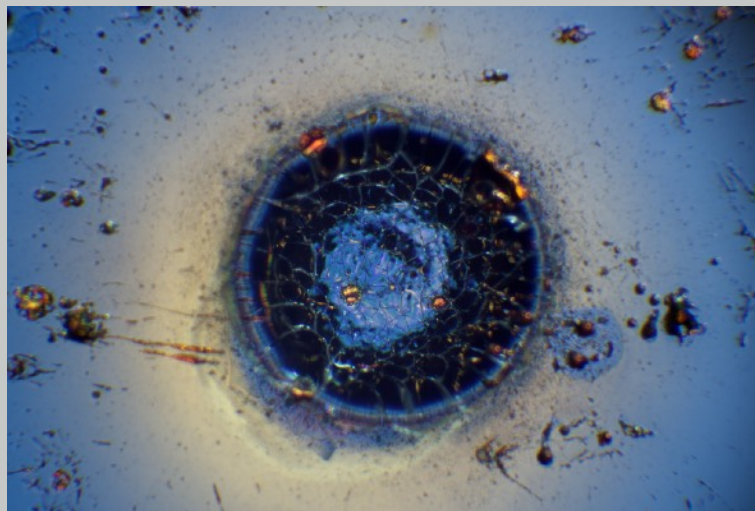

This artwork is a curated microscopic view extracted from a singular physical GLOBE.



Artist's Interpretation

It does not appear stable.

Yet it has not collapsed.

A dark circular field opens beneath the surface —
drawing fragments,
traces,
and fine metallic structures toward itself.

The closer the shape is observed,
the less fixed the structure becomes.

Its boundaries begin to dissolve.
Cracks spread across the surrounding surface
while the center deepens
into something that feels less like a form
than a condition.

Depending on the focal depth,
the vortex shifts between two states:
one revealing an illuminated, brittle interior,
the other revealing the fragility surrounding it.

Neither interpretation replaces the other.

Both belong to the same uncertain reality.



What appears almost gravitational
is not constructed.

It is the physical result
of matter exposed to extreme conditions —
captured at a scale
where coherence itself becomes fragile.

The image does not resolve into a fixed center.

It remains suspended
between attraction and collapse —
as if the structure were still
slowly pulling itself inward.



Contextual Closure

“Fragile Vortex” exists as a singular, non-reproducible motif physically originating from a microscopic metal landscape formed through laser-induced material interaction on and within its corresponding EVOLAS GLOBE.

The structure documented in this artwork is not constructed, simulated, or digitally generated.

It represents the irreversible material result of extreme interaction between laser light, metal, thermal processes, and glass — observed and artistically revealed through microscopic exploration.

Unlike previous EVOLAS motifs centered primarily on isolated figurative structures, “Fragile Vortex” encompasses an extended spatial interaction field including:

- thermally affected glass regions,
- fracture structures,
- layered reaction zones,
- and surrounding deposition environments.

The work is presented through two distinct perceptual states derived from the same unchanged physical structure.

These differing appearances emerge exclusively through variations in focal depth during microscopic observation.

No structural modification or digitally constructed alteration was applied between the two documented visual states.

The visual transformation therefore originates directly from the layered spatial reality of the material itself.

Rather than presenting a fixed image with stable visual hierarchy, the work reveals multiple perceptual conditions embedded within a single physical configuration.

In addition to the main motif documented here, the same GLOBE contains a limited number of further distinct motifs identified within adjacent or structurally related regions of the same microscopic material landscape.



These additional motifs were individually explored, selected, and artistically articulated as part of the broader visual environment associated with this GLOBE.

Collectors who acquire “Fragile Vortex” obtain exclusive access rights to these additional motifs associated with the same physical origin. Details on these motifs are documented separately within the corresponding Preview Gallery.

The acquisition of this artwork encompasses not only the associated digital image files and NFT registration, but also a documented ownership relationship to the underlying physical GLOBE from which the motif materially originates.

Depending on the defined edition structure, ownership rights associated with the physical GLOBE may exist either exclusively or proportionally among multiple edition holders.

This ensures that the artwork remains permanently linked to its physical source and documented material reality.
